

WORDS OF WELCOME

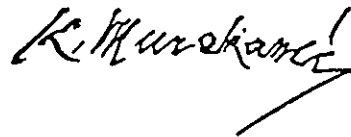
The Seventh International Congress of Pediatric Nephrology will be held in Tokyo, Japan. The Organizing Committee made an effort to achieve the success of this Congress.
